JAPAN AND KOREA STORM INTO QUARTER-FINALS WITH UNBEATEN RECORD AT ASIAN BOYS' U19 CHAMPIONSHIP

Nay Pyi Taw, Myanmar, April 2, 2017 - In-form Japan and devastating Korea topped their pools after completion of playoff matches in the round of the last eight teams at the SMM 11th Asian Boys' U19 Volleyball Championship at the Wunna Theikdi Indoor Stadium on Sunday.

Scintillating blocks and solid defence key to Korea's come-from-behind 3-2 win over China

Korea recovered from the first two-set loss to power past China in hard-fought five-set thriller 14-25 23-25 25-14 25-23 16-14 to top Pool F,

China fielded tall and towering players including the 204cm-Zhang Jingyin, the 203cm-Xiu Chengcheng and the 199cm-Qi Qi in the crucial match to decide the Pool F winners. The China's exceptional teamwork, stuff blocks and devastating attacks led by Zhang proved too much for the hapless Koreans to go down 14-25 in the first set. Korea tightened their defence and fared better in the second set, but their good show was just a step behind the formidable rivals. China snared the close second set 25-23.

Korea stormed back in the third set. With ace spiker Im Donghyeok tearing the Chinese defence into pieces with his deadly attacks, Korea took the comfortable set 25-14. The fourth set was more thrilling when both sides poured everything they had to win the set. Im Donghyeok scored the last point for the Korea's 25-23 win.

In the do-or-die tie-breaker, both sides fought gallantly to win the set and match, but Korea fared better to win the thriller 16-14.

Iran put it past fighting Chinese Taipei in hard-fought straight sets

Reigning champions Iran, which had already suffered two losses in this championship including a straight-set letdown to Korea in their opening match, pulled off a hard-fought 26-24 25-19 27-25 win over Chinese Taipei to finish third place in Pool F.

Iran, pursuing dreams of winning their eighth title in the biennial tournament, overcame a strong challenge from Chinese Taipei in the opening set, making use of devastating attacks from Morteza Sharifi, who scored 25 points in the Iran's previous match against China, and Ali Tabari to take the hotly-contested set 26-24. The fired-up side went on their spectacular attacks to win the second set 25-19 and the close third set 27-25.

Mortizera Sharifi led Iran with 16 points including 15 kills. Ali Tabari contributed 12 points through his attack hits. Kan Ming-Hsiu topscored with 10 points for Chinese Taipei.

Iran's head coach Mohammad Vakili commented after the match, "Chinese Taipei are a strong team with experienced players. They have motivation, skills and good reception the other teams can't underestimate. So, it's a very difficult job for us to play them. We lost to China on Saturday and we have to beat Chinese Taipei. To do that, we analyzed Chinese Taipei carefully and we knew what we have to do. In the third set, Chinese Taipei tried hard to beat us, but we shattered their hopes. However, we need great experience to do that because we fell behind by five points. Fortunately, we learn how to handle such situation, coming from behind to win the set. It's possible that we will take on Thailand in the quarter-finals, but I think Chinese Taipei are stronger than Thailand. We beat Chinese Taipei, so why we can't beat Thailand. To qualify for the World Championship, we have to beat Thailand on Monday."

Japan thrash hosts Myanmar in one-sided battle to make clean sweep of Pool E

Japan brushed off Myanmar in a lop-sided battle 25-15 25-9 25-16 at their final playoff match in the round of the last eight teams to top Pool E on Sunday.

Unbeaten Japan, silver medallists at the previous edition in Sri Lanka in 2014, fielded a strong line-up led by left-hander Kento Miyaura and Mahiro Saeki in the first set against hosts Myanmar to comfortably win 25-15. Despite mounting a challenge, Myanmar still proved to have no answer with the rivals' excellent offensive combinations and fierce attacks. Japan captured the second and third sets 25-9, 25-16 and match.



Sato Shunichiro led Japan with 9 points including 6 kill blocks and 1 ace serve. Tatsunori Otsuka contributed 7 kills. Aung Saw Htet collected 10 points for Myanmar.

Japan's head coach Hiroshi Honda was satisfied with his team's great service, citing that it was a key factor which led to the team's victory. "We did well in serves. So, we could play easily. In the second set, we changed several players in the second set not because we were sure of victory in the set, but we just wanted to change our rhythm after Myanmar came up with improved service. In the quarter-finals, we will play Chinese Taipei and I think they perform well defensively, especially their reception. It will be very difficult to beat them and our chances of beating them is just 50-50."

Australia overpower Thailand in dramatic four sets

Australia defied against all odds to pull off a surprise 25-22 25-20 21-25 25-17 win over Thailand in their last playoff encounter in the round of last eight team on Sunday.

James Takken led Australia with 18 points including 12 kills and 4 ace serves. Thomas Heptinstall contributed 14 attack hits, while Jayden Fathers handed the team 5 block points. Chaiwat Thungkham topscored with 15 points for Thailand, all of them through his deadly attacks.

After the match, Australia's Andrew McCaskill commented, "We played three very good sets even though we lost one set, that set we also played very well. Thailand took away the area of the game. I think Thailand did not play their best today. We lost two games to Thailand during our training together in Bangkok, but they are a very good team. Like our team, they are very young. We can see them strong in one year time. We next take on the losers between China and Korea, but it's just another day, another game. We will do our best. For the win over Thailand, I think it's beyond my expectation. We did not play well yesterday against Myanmar, but we played really well today against Thailand."

At the end of the two-day playoff matches in the round of the last eight teams, Japan top Pool E with nine points from three straight wins, while Thailand, Australia and Myanmar had the similar three points from one win against two losses, but Thailand had better set ratio to finish second. Australia and the host side came in third and fourth places respectively.

Korea top Pool F with 8 points from three wins in a row, followed by China. Title-holders Iran finished third, with Chinese Taipei in fourth place.

In the Monday's knock-out quarter-finals, which will decide the top four teams in the semi-finals to win four slots for the FIVB Volleyball Boys' U19 World Championship in Bahrain coming August, Japan (1E) take on Chinese Taipei (4F), Thailand (2E) go up against Iran (3F), Australia (3E) challenge China (2F) and Myanmar (4E) face Korea (1F).

Meanwhile, Bangladesh narrowly beat Hong Kong 3-2 (25-10 18-25 16-25 25-23 15-11) in the 9th-11th classification round.
