COMPETITION	*Timetable for practice will be provided on-site.
FORMAT	Pool play followed by a single elimination tournament (Round of 16, QF, SF, and Finals)
COUNTRY ENTRY	Maximum 2 Women's and 2 Men's Teams per each National Federation.
NUMBERS	Only host National Federation can enter a maximum of 3 Women's and
NONDERS	3 Men's Teams.
ATHLETES'	AGE LIMIT FOR UNDER 21 must be born on January 1st, 2003
ELIGIBILITY	and thereafter.
AVC QUOTA TO	The first 5 best ranked NFs of the 5th Asian U21 Beach Volleyball
FIVB U21 WORLD	Championships will be qualified to Main Draw of U21 World
CHAMPIONSHIPS	Championships. The next 4 best ranked NFs will be qualified to QT of U21
	World Championships. The rest NFs who participate in the 5 th Asian U21
	Beach Volleyball Championships but not in the qualified rank can
	propose to be the reserve teams.
	In case there are more than one team from the NFs in the qualified rank,
	the quota will be reallocated to next best ranked NFs. In case there is a
	tie in the ranking, a special match will be conducted during the 5th Asian
	U21 Beach Volleyball Championship to determine the qualified NF.
	Thailand, as the host of U21 World Championships, will not be counted
	towards the AVC quota.

TEAM REGISTRATION	NFs must both register teams through FIVB Online Registration System at www.fivb.org/vis/ and submit the entry form, rooming list, and all participants' passports to the Host NF (info@volleyball.or.th) and AVC Beach Volleyball Department (beachvolleyball@asianvolleyball.net) CC: avc.bk@asianvolleyball.net within June 8, 2023 (-35 days). IMPORTANT: Otherwise, the teams will not be eligible to participate in the event. If the federations have any problems in register teams in VIS
	system, please contact AVC Beach Department for further assistance.
ENTRY/SEEDING POINTS	- The federation points are calculated from the sum of 2 best finished teams of NF from each AVC tournament in the last 365 days (Maximum 4 events in total, and only 1 Asian Sr Championships will be counted.)
	- Seeding and Entry Regulations and Withdrawal: in accordance with the decisions of the AVC Beach Volleyball Committee.

PRELIMINARY	Preliminary Inquiry: July 11, 2023
INQUIRY	Time/Place to be confirmed. Teams will be allocated a Preliminary Inquiry time. Players must attend the Preliminary Inquiry and present passport/traveling document during the inquiry.
TECHNICAL	General Technical Meeting: July 12, 2023
MEETING	Time/Place to be confirmed.
	Players must also attend the General Technical Meeting. Draws will be made (if necessary) during the meeting; seeding and detailed information on the competition will be announced to players during the meeting.
UNIFORMS	Players' tops will be provided by the Organizers to the athletes.
RULES OF THE GAME & OFFICIAL BALL	As per FIVB Rules of the Game & Sports Regulations Mikasa BV-550C
FORFEIT & WITHDRAWAL	Each NF is responsible for informing immediately both the AVC and Organizers in case of forfeit of an enrolled team. Such withdrawal shall be sent to AVC and organizer at least 3 days before the tournament starts. In case of urgency, verbal communication to either AVC or its official on-site will be accepted.

AVC OFFICIALS	AVC will appoint 2 AVC officials (1 Technical Delegate, 1 Referee
	Delegate) and 3-4 Neutral Referees.
	- AVC will be responsible for AVC officials per diem, and round-trip air
	ticket. The organizer will be responsible for AVC officials full board and

COACHING	Coaches must be approved by the AVC Delegate and desirably be
	accredited by the AVC as a minimum.
ANTI-DOPING	AVC reserves the right to perform random anti-doping controls, as per

INSURANCE	It is mandatory that all athletes and officials have their own liability and
