### 3. Competition

#### Team registration

IMPORTANT: Otherwise, the teams will not be eligible to participate in the event. If the federations have any problems in register teams in VIS system, please contact AVC Beach Department for further assistance.

#### Player's eligibility

- Age limit for Under 19 – players must be born on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006 and thereafter**
- Only players, who have sent to the AVC and the organizer the required forms, and register in the VIS system will be considered eligible to take part in this event.

#### Competition format

Pool play followed by a single elimination tournament (Round of 16, QF, SF, and Finals)

#### Country entry numbers

- Maximum 2 teams per gender each National Federation.  
Only host National Federation can enter a maximum of 3 teams.
- In case the Main Draw is not full (less than 24 teams), the reserve team from Host NF and the reserve team(s) with the most points among all participating NFs' reserve teams will be selected to fill the Main Draw.

#### AVC Quota to FIVB U19 World Championships

- The first 5 best ranked NFs of the 5th Asian U19 Beach Volleyball Championships will be qualified to Main Draw of U19 World Championships. The next 4 best ranked NFs will be qualified to QT of U19 World Championships. The rest NFs who participate in the 5th Asian U19 Beach Volleyball Championships can propose to be the reserve teams.
- In case there are more than one team from the NFs in the qualified rank, the quota will be reallocated to next best ranked NFs. In case there is a tie in the ranking, a special match will be conducted during the 5th Asian U19 Beach Volleyball Championship to determine the qualified NF.
- China, as the host of U19 World Championships, will not be counted towards the AVC quota.

#### Entry & Seeding points

- The federation points are calculated from the sum of 2 best finished teams of NF from each AVC tournament in the last 365 days (Maximum 4 events in total, and only 1 Asian Sr Championships will be counted.)

#### Forfeit & Withdrawal

- Each NF is responsible for informing immediately both the AVC and organizers in case of forfeit of an enrolled team. Such withdrawal shall be sent to AVC and organizer at least 3 days before the tournament starts. In case of urgency, verbal communication to either AVC or its official on-site will be accepted.

- Attendance to the Preliminary Enquiry and Technical Meeting is mandatory for both team athletes. Athletes must bring their uniform, including any headgear, armbands or other pieces of uniform intended to be used during matches for approval of the Technical Delegate. #### Training

- Please note that official training starts as from **29 April 2024**.
- Training session reservations can be made no more than 24 hours in advance.
- Each team is entitled to make one reservation per day (i.e. teams cannot reserve multiple training sessions for the week ahead).
- Additional training sessions may be possible only if the courts are available.
- Athletes must register in the training booking platform at least 24 hours before the intended training session.

#### Match schedule

- The detailed match-up schedule will be confirmed after the completion of the General Technical Meeting.

#### Mixed Zones and Press Conferences

- Athletes may be asked to attend mixed zone interviews after each match, while still in competition uniform. The scheduling of press conferences will be communicated to athletes in advance. All athletes are required to attend the press conference(s), if requested

- Players' tops will be provided by the organizer to the athletes.

#### 4. Accommodation and others

##### Accommodation

- The host organizer will cover for the full board and lodging for players from the official arrival day until breakfast on the day after elimination or until breakfast of the official departure day.
- Athletes will be personally responsible for all extras at the hotel such as mini-bar, phone calls, etc. including any damage incurred to the room. Payments must be made upon checkout.
- Organizers will not cover for the accommodation of coaches, team physiotherapists, guests or family members accompanying the participating athletes.

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- The rate of full board and lodging for extra members:
  - Single bedroom/room/night with 3 meals a day – USD 90
  - Twin bedroom/room/night with 3 meals a day – USD 140 (2 persons/room)

***Note:** Please carefully reading regarding the accommodation price due to the organizer has changed price rate from per person into per room instead*

##### Accompanying referees

- The host organizer may support accommodation and per diem for the accompanying referees from participating NFs if any.

##### Transportation

- The official airport confirmed by the organizer is as follows:

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- Players and team officials have to be responsible for the domestic flight vice versa (if any).
- The organizer will arrange local transportation and welcome all participants at the mentioned airport. The travel details of the teams must be sent to the event office before **19 April 2024**

##### Accreditation

- Accreditation will be required by all athletes, coaches and team officials, AVC officials, referees, VIPs, media, technical staff, court personnel, volunteers, vendors, etc. by organizers, and will ensure that only those with appropriate accreditation can access the designated venue areas.

#### Catering

- Organizer will provide all three meals for athletes, referees, and AVC officials being breakfast, lunch and dinner at the official hotel.
- Meals will be arranged by the organizer from the official arrival day until breakfast of the day after the team was eliminated from the event or until breakfast of the official departure day.

#### Medical Services and procedures

- During Competition & Training
  - During Competition & Training, there will be a first responders with an ambulance will be on standby at the venue
  - AVC reserves the right to perform random anti-doping controls, as per FIVB rules and regulations.
- Out of Competition & Training
  - For Out of Competition & Training there will be the option to arrange a first aid treatment in the hotel. If more treatment is necessary, local organizer will provide a transportation where needed.
